ANNUAL REPORT 2014-2015

The Sai Seva Sangh Hyderabad was established in 1988 to serve the destitute senior citizens, orphans, physically, mentally and visually handicapped children and others in need. The office bearers of the Sangh include Businessmen and Social workers Senior Administrative Officers. The Sangh was associated with the welfare programmes of Government (both State and Central) like vocational guidance programmes for street children and women. The Sangh besides maintaining an old age home for destitute persons has been maintaining Sri Satya Sai Vidya Mandir school for the benefit of children of slum dwellers mostly living on daily wages at Moosapet, Ranga Reddy District Hyderabad with a strength of 300 children. The School is being maintained purely on contributions from devotees of Sri Sathya Sai Baba and philanthropists.

Sai Seva Sangh has started with the primary objective of giving free education to those who are utterly poor and belong to SC and ST communities in the Moosapet area. Sai Seva Sangh has started the school in the year 1994 from Ist class to Xth class. Seeing the interest of the children the school was extended up to Xth class. We are a Recognised school of the Sate Government with 10th class being the final class. Eleven batches have completed 10th class so far. This year 100 % students who appeared for the X class exams conducted by the state board passed, School children participated in the walk for values programme conducted by Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisation. Primary section from class 1 to 6 were given access to computer English lessons to improve their grammar and communication skills.

We are giving clothing to all the students besides free textbooks, notebooks, bags, and other educational material. Most of these children are either orphans or have a single parent. These children also learn moral values along with their regular education. 90 children who have passed out of our school are being supported financially to pursue their higher education in various professional fields like nursing, engineering, accountancy etc.

During 2014—2015 the Sangh has maintained the Old Age Home at Moosapet with (25) twenty five inmates who have been provided with Pucca Building, Food, Clothing and Medical Care free of cost. The inmates were also provided with newspapers, magazines, radio and television for their use. The inmates have been taken on outings to pilgrimage centers.

During 2014-2015 the Sangh has maintained Sri Bhagawan Satya Sai School for mentally retarded at Jammikunta, Karimnagar District, Andhra Pradesh with (95) children with requisite staff and other equipment. Accounts were opened in post office to 5 differently able students to deposit their earnings from vocational centre. Two differently able students along with their teacher attended a orientation programme in January, 2015 for a week in data entry operating system. Now the special school is the partner centre in data entry. Two additional class rooms and a water purifier were added to the facility this year. A cultural programme was presented by the differently able students at 'N' convention centre, Hyderabad in association with Dr. Reddy's Labs.

Five room accommodation (Panchavati) for the orphanage and an exclusive open prayer cum event hall were inaugurated on June 8th as an additional facility. The hall fortunately was immediately utilised on the same evening by the presentation of folk art by the former students of Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning, Prashanthi Nilayam. Another day in the same venue the students were mesmerised by the presentation of a Guinness world record holder on mind power and concentration. Students participated in the Knowledge show Industry & Career opportunities conducted by Capital IQ. Festivals of all religions and national festivals were celebrated with grate enthusiasm by the children and staff of the institute.
