Sai Seva Sangh is a charitable organization established in the year 1988. It has been relentlessly working towards the cause of providing free integral education to children coming from the lower economic strata of our society. It focuses on academic and non-academic learning; nurturing confidence, self-esteem, self-awareness and mould them as ideal citizens devoted to the service of society.

- Aims to ensure that every child of school-going age gains a strong and holistic educational foundation to become a responsible, compassionate and Self- reliant confident citizen of tomorrow.
- Through its free quality value-based education focusses on the all-round holistic development of the student. It aims to provide an environment to explore the innate potential of the individual.
- Runs an Orphanage for Girls focussing on the mainstreaming of education and other skill developmental programmes.
- Provides shelter to destitute ladies & Old age women. It provides skill development programmes thereby empowering women totally.
- Has so far impacted more than 18000 beneficiaries.

The groundwork for what is SAI SEVA SANGH today was laid in August 1988, when a few like-minded people came together for a common cause to educate underprivileged children in their neighbourhood, providing free shelter to old and destitute women, **All the services rendered under various units of Sai Seva Sangh are free of cost.**

Sai Seva Sangh is being supported by Philanthropists and a group of individual patrons & organizations supporting the cause by way of contributions in kind & cash. Volunteerism is a major support in the form of teachers (Academic & Non-Academic).

Our Vision

To empower a **girl child** through integral education focused on academic and non-academic learning, nurturing confidence, self-esteem and moulding them as ideal citizens devoted to the service of society. To empower destitute women by providing shelter and skill development programmes, thus enhancing their financial sustenance.

Our Mission

To enable a brighter future for **girl children & women** from low-income communities by providing them the desired knowledge, skills & values and support, to achieve their true potential.

Objectives

To provide holistic learning to the under privileged in order to maximise their potential.

To instil confidence and self-esteem through exposure to art, dance, sports & other activities

To empower destitute women towards better employment and quality of life.

To provide shelter for old women to lead a dignified quality life and experience the love and care of a family.

Sai Seva Sangh runs a School, Orphanage for **girl children**, Shelter for Destitute Women & Old Age home for Women.

It also renders community service as an organization with the participation of various stakeholders. It also conducts various vocational trainings to enhance and update skills for students and women.

Sai Seva Sangh has supported students in pursuing their higher education in various fields like Engineering, Nursing, Pharma & Teacher Training.

1. School – Sri Satya Sai Vidya Mandir School

The School aims to provide a solid and holistic educational foundation to children from slums and low-income communities completely free of cost. It aims to bridge the learning gaps and ensure that the children pursue their schooling, this addressing drop outs. Teaching methods focus not only on academic education but also on non-academic learning to mould and nurture confidence, self-esteem and self-awareness. Upholding the principle of holistic learning, the curriculum is implemented through lecture, demonstrations and experiments as well as experiential learning through celebrations, events, field trips and workshops.



1. School – Sri Satya Sai Vidya Mandir School

Assessments are conducted on a regular basis with the purpose of ensuring that the students are gaining in-depth knowledge of the subjects. Student academic performance analysis enables us to identify students with remedial needs; students with learning disabilities and thereby take steps to enhance them. Baseline and end line studies are conducted for students to bridge the gaps with clearly defined outcomes. Teachers' skills are updated continuously through trainings by professionals on classroom management, assessments and other related topics.



2. Orphanage for Girls – 100 inmates

As an Off shoot of the school, the orphanage was started in the year 2005. Children who lost both their parents due to tragic circumstances are referred through various government, non-government institutions & individuals' patrons. The home also shelters girls who are victims of the society and has a single parent. These students are counselled, mentored & assessed as per their age and are slowly main streamed to the existing school to continue their education.

The children stay in collaboration with the old age & destitute women inmates thus enabling a family home atmosphere nurturing love & care.



3. Destitute Women & Old Age Home

The old age home has 25 inmates. The old age home and the orphanage together is a great boon for both thus creating a family affinity and love. The Women help in cooking, cutting vegetables and taking care of the orphan girls as per their capacity and interest. Medical needs of the women are attended to immediately with an in-house nurse stationed at home.

The destitute women have 60 inmates. They are provided skill development programmes like Tailoring, car driving, bakery, office management, electrical maintenance. The main intention is to enhance their skills thus facilitating a sustainable income in the society.



3. Community Services & Vocational Training

Sai Seva Sangh participates in addressing the community challenges in the slum situated around the school. The various programmes conducted are:

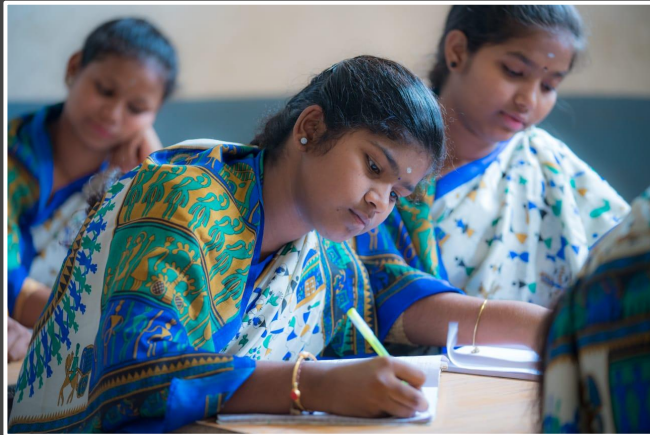
- Monthly medical camps in general with special camps for Pregnant Mothers & Infants.
- Physiotherapy camps
- Health & Hygiene awareness camps
- Facilitate with government departments for providing water, electricity and sanitation for the slum dwellers
- Tailoring & Fashion designing classes for women
- Cooking Classes
- Digital Learning
- Driving classes
- Distributions of provisions to students' families during COVID-19 Crisis.



3. Higher Education

Sai Seva Sangh counsel students to pursue their higher education as per their capabilities. An one-to-one counselling session helps students to make an informed choice towards the path of pursuing their higher education. More than 1000 students are benefited through this programme. Financial support is also provided as per the need and requirement of these students. They are mostly placed in the stream of Nursing, Pharma, Engineering & in the teaching arena.

There are several success stories from Sri Satya Sai Vidya Mandir pursuing higher education and securing good jobs, eventually creating a positive impact on their families and society at large. However there was a void in providing continuous formal education to all these students beyond high school under our supervision, integrating and continuing human values alongside the academic education.



1. 4. Sri Satya Sai Prashanthi Niketanam College for Women, Kondapaka, Siddipet, Telangana

Prashanthi Bala Mandira Trust proposal in the year 2016 to start a free residential all women college in Telangana state bolstered the desire of Sai Seva Sangh to fill in the gap which has now taken shape as “**Sri Satya Sai Prashanthi Niketanam College for Women**”.

Prashanthi Bala Mandira Trust is a public charitable trust which works towards rendering selfless service to the needy. It has set up 20 campuses in districts of Karnataka, providing free education to more than 5000 students from rural background.

Sai Seva Sangh has been chosen as the Implementing Partner of Prashanthi Bala Mandira Trust for **Sri Satya Sai Prashanthi Niketanam College for Women** situated at Kondapaka, near Siddepet in Telangana in the year 2018.

Sri Satya Sai Prashanthi Niketanam Residential College for Women provides free education to girls beyond High School. The students & Parents are counselled and selected through a detailed process of assessments did both academically and through creating awareness to share the vision & mission of the college. Most of the students belong to the economically backward sections of society - 25% are orphans; 15% are single parents; 40% are Daily wage Labourers & 20% belong to other strata of society.

Our Vision

To create a world-class university for Women that provides a unique blend of fine arts and secular education thereby enabling women to be courageous and make them leaders among teachers to promote societal welfare, character and human values.

Our Mission

To impart free higher education with high-quality subject knowledge and greater emphasis on the cultural, moral and spiritual principles of India, thus creating individuals who are:

- Physically strong
- Intellectually stimulated
- Emotionally balanced
- Spiritually inspired

The college offers various courses of NIOS. The students opt to choose the subjects as per their interest and merit, thus allowing them to explore other areas of interests viz., sports, arts, dance etc, which the college offers. The college aims and emphasis the overall development of the student.

Currently, the college houses 250 students who stay along with the Faculty and has a disciplined routine covering all areas of holistic development of the students. They have participated and won medals in Sports, Music, Dance, Karate.

Running a free College

A free institute of this scale and magnitude, although difficult to imagine and comprehend, is not the first. Prashanthi Bala Mandira Trust management has rich experience and also has set up a University in Gulbarga, **“Sri Satya Sai University of Human Excellence”**.

This college belongs to all of us and a collective vision is what is required to make it successful. Something close to home which we will all be proud of – **A college for girls in a state-of-the-art facility, providing meaningful education interlaced with strong human values, free of cost to the students!**

Partnership Opportunities

The need for the construction of a hostel for the girl students is the current requirement of the college. Currently, the students share the constructed area of the college which is a makeshift on available Facility. It is envisaged that within two years, **the student's strength will increase to 600-650.**

Beyond the back-end officials of turning this dream into reality, there is an imminent need for diverse organizations to get associated with this noble cause.

The total construction area for the hostel, Dining and kitchen will be a Total of 79675 sqft. The cost per sqft will be Rs.1700/- per sqft. Hence, Total amount is Rs. 13,54,47,500/-
