## Residential facility for orphan and under privileged girls



- As an off shoot of the school, the orphanage was started in the year 2005
- Children who lost their parents in tragic circumstances are referred through various government, non-government institutions \& individual patrons
- The home also shelters girls who are victims of the society and have a single parent
- These students are counselled, mentored \& assessed as per their age and are enrolled into existing school to continue their education
- The children stay along with the old age \& destitute women inmates thus enabling a family home atmosphere nurturing love \& care


## Community Services \& Vocational Training



Sai Seva Sangh participates in addressing the community challenges in the slum situated around the school. The various programs conducted are:

- Monthly medical camps
- Special camps for Pregnant women \& Infants
- Physiotherapy camps
- Health \& Hygiene awareness camps
- Facilitate with government departments for providing water, electricity and sanitation for the slum dwellers
- Tailoring \& Fashion designing classes for women
- Cooking Classes
- Digital Learning
- Driving classes
- Distribution of provisions to students' families during COVID-19 Crisis.


## Higher Education



- One-on-one counselling session helps students to make an informed choice towards the path of pursuing their higher education
- More than 1000 students have benefited through this program
- Financial support is also provided as per the need and requirement of these students
- They are mostly placed in the stream of Nursing, Pharma, Engineering and in the teaching arena.
- There are several success stories of students pursuing higher education and securing good jobs, eventually creating a positive impact to their families and society at large


## Student beneficiary - Navaneetha

- Navaneetha's father passed away due to AIDS when she was a young child
- Her mother supports the family by working as a daily wage laborer
- Navaneetha is one of four children in the family
- Due to financial constraints, her mother couldn't afford her education
- Navaneetha' s mother enrolled her in Sai Seva Sangh when she was in the 1st standard
- Despite the odds, Navaneetha successfully completed her B.A. degree
- She now serves as an intern at our school, sharing her knowledge and experiences with her younger sisters

In 2024, Navaneetha is set to pursue post-graduate studies, continuing her educational journey

## Student beneficiary - Neha

- Neha tragically lost both her parents at a young age in distressing circumstances

- She is the youngest among her three sisters in the family
- Sai Seva Sangh provides support to Neha and her sisters
- Neha is an incredibly dynamic and active participant in various sports events
- She excels as a basketball player and holds a black belt in karate, with numerous medals at district and state levels.
- She is a dedicated member of the NCC and has undergone training in several self-defense programs.
